9. BSA FACTOID: Who is the only Scout to receive the Gold Eagle Badge? Daniel Carter Beard. The GE Badge was replaced by the Distinguished Eagle Scout Award. Dan Beard founded the Sons of Daniel Boone, a youth organization based on American frontier traditions. The Sons of Daniel Boone merged in the Boy Scouts of America at the founding of BSA in 1910, and Beard served the BSA as a National Scout Commissioner for many years.
