Special Hydration ALERT SAVE YOURSELVES -- DON'T DEHYDRATE!!!

Winter conditions are notorious for Scouts becoming dehydrated...

What Happens? Dizziness, nausea, throwing up, headaches!!!

Begin hydrating with a lot of water at least a week prior...

No sodas or caffeine drinks after Wednesday

No sodas are allowed during the camp-out!!!

Make sure you have good boots (some are available in the troop room), thermal long-johns (top and bottom), soft plastic bottles, etc. A winter survival packing list is available at the front desk of the Troop room.
