**8.** <u>BSA FACTOID:</u> : Here's an interesting piece of BSA history....In the early years of scouting, institutions such as Cornell University, Columbia University, University of Texas and University of California began offering training for Scout leaders. By the mid-1930's, more than 400 colleges and 34 seminaries offered BSA courses. Most of these were for college credit.
