Do you know....Who the first Scoutmaster of Boy Scouts of America was?

It was S. F. Lester in Troy, New York. He was commissioned as the Scoutmaster of Troop 1 on September 10, 1910. Mr. Troy had established a group of 30 junior scouts and led them on a 35 mile hike from Vermont to New York to receive his commissioning. To my best research, 12 of these first 30 boys achieved the rank of Eagle Scout.

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
