10. **BSA FACTOID:** February 8<sup>th</sup> is the 105<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Boy Scouts of America. On this day in 1910, Chicago publisher William Dickson Boyce filed the official paperwork to create the Boy Scouts on this side of the Atlantic from the Scout's homeland of England. By the end of 1910, there were more than 8,000 boys involved in BSA. Today there are 3.1 million boys in America's scouting program. Through the years, that total is more than 109,000,000 who have worn the Scout uniform.
