1. **Backpacking Campout:** June 5-7; Due to probable weather concerns north of McCall in the area of Loon Lake we will probably be headed to Box Canyon/1000 springs! Food for this campout is on your own, so if you need input or ideas about how to make that happen, please tell someone, and we will give you some ideas. We will need to do a gear check prior as well, so we can make sure everyone has access to the gear they need. Let Mr. Forras know if you need something.
2. **Summer Camp:** Due to scheduling conflicts and the inability to find another Troop to partner with, Summer Camp will not be an option this year. We are exploring an alternate, in the form of a merit badge series/camp, so talk to your leadership about what merit badges you would want to see presented.

Form C is a physical – this takes more time to complete so please be aware of whether you are up to date and assume that you are not if you aren't sure. The Borah hike will take place on the weekend of July 31 through August 2. The hike will require physical training, and is a strenuous hike. All participants will need to pass a physical test and Scouts will need to be First Class or higher rank.
